# Ways to help your child...

Our homework is handed out each week on a Friday. It is usually a Maths and English piece of work that is based on the learning that has happened that week. It needs to be in on the following Wednesday. Weekly spellings come out each Monday to be tested at the end of the week.

### Science

Our science focus for the half term will be the circle of life. We will be investigating the how we develop from children to adults and the effects of aging on our bodies as well as these processes in animals.

## History

We will study the history of Ancient Egypt including mummification, the pharaohs and Egyptian gods.

# Geography

We will explore the human and physical features of Egypt and the River Nile.

## **RE/PSHE**

In RE, we will be looking at the influence of Resurrection on Christians. We will be exploring how this effects their views on life after death. In PSHE we will be looking at Managing Safety and Risks as well as Keeping Safe online.

### Maths

This term the children in Year 5 will be continuing to look at fractions as well as exploring decimals and properties of shapes. Year 6 will be using all the topic areas to solve problems and develop their reasoning skills. #### Arts

### Music

# English

In English, we will be focusing on Classic Narrative
Poetry as well as persuasive texts. During this topic we
will explore the text 'The Phoenix Code' by Hellen

tests and encourage daily reading at home.
